

# Mother Earth Application Rates

## APPLICATIONS

**ALWAYS WATER YOUR GARDEN THOROUGHLY AFTER EACH APPLICATION OF MOTHER EARTH.**

(One adult handful holds about 75g. One cupful holds about 100g.)

**Flowers and Vegetable Beds:** Spread 100g per square metre prior to planting, and then every six weeks during the growing season.

**Native Shrubs, Azaleas, Rhododendrons and Acid-Loving Plants:**

Starting 15cm from the plant trunk, apply 50g to 75g per square metre.

Apply in Spring and again in Autumn.

**Ornamental Shrubs and Roses:** Starting 10cm from the plant trunk, apply 100g per square metre every 6 weeks from Spring until mid Autumn.

**Fruit Trees (All Types):** Young Trees: Apply 500g to 1kg per tree in Spring and Autumn. Established Trees: Apply 2kg to 3kg per tree in Spring and Autumn. Apply around the drip line of the tree, avoiding direct contact with the trunk.

**Potted Plants:** Apply 10g for a 15cm diameter pot, or 30g for a 30cm pot.

**Planting Trees and Shrubs:** When planting, apply between 200g and 500g into the hole before planting. (500g is recommended for large trees.)

**Lawns:** Apply 100g per square metre or use Paton's No 17 Lawn Food which is specifically formulated for this purpose.
